1. **The Rider On The White Horse:**

- What is the significance of his “White” horse?
 - His Bow? (**Psalm 45:5**)
 - His Crown? (**Stephanos – victory crown**)
- Who/what is he conquering?

2. **The Rider On The Red Horse:**

- What is the significance of his “Red” horse? (**Isaiah 1:18, Revelation 12:3**)
- Historically, what did he accomplish by his power?
- Who calls forth each of the horsemen?

3. **The Rider On The Black Horse:**

- What is the significance of his “Black” horse? (**Isaiah 50:3, Jeremiah 14:2**)
- What does his mission accomplish? (**Shilling=Day’s wage**)
- Why is the oil and wine left undamaged?

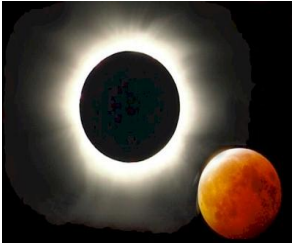
4. **The Rider On The Pale Horse:**

- What is the significance of his “Pale” horse?
- What is “Hades”?
- What does he accomplish with his power?
